Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy ("Cookie Policy") explains how Harvestime Proprietary Limited (registration number 2023/214018/07), a company incorporated under the laws of the Republic of South Africa, with its principal place of business at 11 Hasset Road, Nuffield, Springs, Ekurhuleni, Gauteng, 1559 ("Harvestime", "we", "us", or "our") uses cookies and similar technologies on our website. It should be read together with our Privacy Policy and our Website Terms and Conditions, which are available on this Website. This Cookie Policy is issued in terms of the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 ("POPIA") and the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act 25 of 2002 ("ECT Act").

What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your device (computer, tablet, or mobile phone) when you visit a website. Cookies allow the website to recognise your device, remember your preferences, and understand how the website is being used. Cookies do not damage your device and do not give us access to any other files on it.

We use both "session cookies", which are deleted when you close your browser, and "persistent cookies", which remain on your device until they expire or you delete them. We also use "first-party cookies", which are set by Harvestime, and "third-party cookies", which are set by service providers acting on our behalf.

Which Cookies Do We Use?

We use the following categories of cookies on our Website:

Category	Purpose	Duration
Strictly Necessary	Enable core Website functions such as page navigation, security, load balancing, form submission, and remembering your cookie choices. The Website cannot function properly without these cookies and they cannot be disabled through our cookie banner.	Session to 12 months
Preference	Remember choices you make, such as your language, region, and display settings, so that we can provide a more personalised experience on return visits.	Up to 12 months
Analytics and Performance	Help us understand how visitors use the Website — which pages are visited, how long visitors spend on them, and whether any errors occur — so that we can improve the Website. This information is aggregated and statistical in nature.	Up to 24 months

Category	Purpose	Duration
Marketing and Advertising	Track browsing activity across websites so that we can measure the effectiveness of our campaigns and, where relevant, show you content about Harvestime products that is more likely to be of interest.	Up to 24 months
Social Media	Set by social media platforms when the Website embeds their content or share buttons, enabling you to share pages and interact with our social media accounts.	Up to 24 months

The specific cookies in use may change from time to time as we update the Website. Current details, including the names of individual cookies, are available from our Information Officer on request.

Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies are placed by third parties that provide services to us, including website analytics providers, content delivery networks, and social media platforms. These third parties process information in accordance with their own privacy and cookie policies, and we encourage you to review those policies. Where a third party acts as an operator on our behalf in terms of POPIA, we require it to process information only on our instructions and to apply appropriate security safeguards.

Other Tracking Technologies

In addition to cookies, we may use the following technologies for the purposes set out above:

- **Pixels and Web Beacons** Small transparent image files that allow us to record whether a page has been viewed or an email has been opened.
- **Local Storage** Browser-based storage used to hold small amounts of data on your device to support Website functionality and performance.
- **Server Logs** Records automatically generated when you access the Website, including your IP address, browser type and version, time zone setting, operating system, and pages visited, used for security, diagnostics, and analytics.

How Do We Obtain Your Consent?

When you first visit our Website, you will be presented with a cookie notice that allows you to accept or decline cookies that are not strictly necessary. Strictly necessary cookies are placed on the basis of our legitimate interest in operating a secure and functional Website, and do not require your consent. All other cookies are placed only once you have provided consent.

You may withdraw or change your consent at any time by adjusting your cookie preferences through the cookie notice or by clearing cookies in your browser settings. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before the withdrawal.

How Can You Manage or Disable Cookies?

Most browsers allow you to view, manage, delete, and block cookies. You can ordinarily do this through the privacy or security settings of your browser, and you can set your browser to notify you before a cookie is placed. The relevant instructions are available in the help section of your browser:

- **Google Chrome** Settings → Privacy and security → Third-party cookies.
- **Microsoft Edge** Settings → Cookies and site permissions.
- **Mozilla Firefox** Settings → Privacy & Security → Cookies and Site Data.
- **Safari** Settings → Privacy → Manage Website Data.

Please note that if you block or delete cookies, certain parts of the Website may not function as intended, and your saved preferences may be lost.

Do Not Track

Some browsers offer a "Do Not Track" signal. There is currently no uniform standard for responding to these signals, and our Website does not presently respond to them. You can nevertheless control cookies through the mechanisms described above.

Cookies and Your Personal Information

Where information collected through cookies can be used to identify you, it constitutes Personal Information and is processed in accordance with our Privacy Policy. That Policy explains the lawful bases on which we process Personal Information, the parties to whom we may disclose it, how long we keep it, and the rights available to you under POPIA — including the right to access, correct, or delete your Personal Information, to object to processing, and to lodge a complaint with the Information Regulator.

Updates to This Cookie Policy

We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes in the technologies we use, our practices, or legal requirements. We will notify you of material changes by posting the updated Cookie Policy on our website and updating the effective date. Your continued use of our website after any update constitutes acceptance of the revised Cookie Policy.
